This is the line of Noah—Noah was a righteous man; he was blameless **in his generations**; Noah walked with God.

Rashi

יש מרבותינו דורשים אותו לשבח... ויש שדורשים אותו לגנאי לפי דורו היה צדיק ואלו היה בדורו של אברהם לא היה נחשב לכלום:

There are those among our Rabbis who interpret this as praise... and there are those who interpret this as an insult—in his generation he was righteous, but had he been in the generation of **Abraham**, he would have been considered as nothing.

7. Genesis 7
